

Lifeline

Lifeline is a federal program that lowers the monthly cost of phone and internet. Eligible customers will get up to \$9.25 credit toward their bill. You can only use Lifeline for either phone or internet, but not both.

Do I Qualify?

You can get Lifeline if you (or someone in your household) participates in one of these federal assistance programs:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as Food Stamps
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
- Tribal Programs (and live on federally-recognized Tribal lands)
- Qualify Through Your Child or Dependent (if your child or dependent participates in any of the programs listed above)
