RESTRICT UNWANTED TELEPHONE SOLICITATIONS. In 2003, the Do-Not-Call Act was signed into law. This legislation allowed for the establishment and enforcement of a national Do-Not-Call Registry giving consumers a choice regarding telemarketing calls. If your number is listed on the registry, all commercial telemarketers, except for businesses with whom you have an existing relationship or certain non-profit and political organizations, are not allowed to call you.

Consumers may register their residential telephone number, including wireless numbers on the national Do-Not-Call Registry via the Internet at no cost.

You can register online at www.donotcall.gov. Registration will remain in effect until you cancel it or the telephone number is disconnected. If you change your telephone number for any reason, you must re-register.
